

#### St. Anthony's Hospital



Impression of living conditions in Ghana. - Images of daily life, groups of Ghanaians posing for the camera and household chores; - adults and children; - truck with medical devices; - container with Orion tools; - babies are vaccinated; - population gets water from a well constructed by Orion; - activities in pharmacy; doctors treat patients; - children do rehabilitation exercises; - volunteers dig a trench for electricity cables for the construction of a hospital. \* Interviews about the health centers, the vaccination program and the use of solar panels.

With this cry for help, SOSSAH went to St. Medic in Apeldoorn. They responded very quickly and helpfully. Thanks to the joint efforts of St. Medic project leader Auke Wiersma, Govert van den Nieuwenhuyzen, Joost van der Meulen of Biomedic, Dr. Kees van Egmond of St. Kind op de Been (Orthopedic Assistance Foundation), Godson (clinical engineer manager), management from St. Anthony's and SOSSAH, a solution was found and a new hard drive was brought to Ghana and successfully deployed.
